SHALL THE VOTERS OF THE PAINÉ MOUNTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT APPROVE THE PAINÉ MOUNTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD TO EXPEND \$18,517,223 WHICH IS THE AMOUNT THE SCHOOL BOARD HAS DETERMINED TO BE NECESSARY FOR THE ENSUING FISCAL YEAR FOR THE PAINÉ MOUNTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICT. THIS REPRESENTS A -0.01% DECREASE FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT THIS PROPOSED BUDGET, IF APPROVED, WILL RESULT IN EDUCATION SPENDING OF \$16,349 PER EQUALIZED PUPIL.
